

Tour of New Orleans - Locations from DR. MARY'S MONKEY by Edward T. Haslam

The book **DR. MARY'S MONKEY** contains many locations all over New Orleans. (See p. 268.) Here is an outline of the major locations, organized in clusters for touring convenience. Get a good street map to assist you in your navigation. This is not a substitute.

Abbreviations: ETH = Edward T. Haslam, LHO = Lee Harvey Oswald, JVB = Judyth Vary Baker

French Quarter - walking tour

126 Exchange Place, ½ block east of Royal and Canal

where LHO lived as a teen, when he worked in Marcello's restaurants for his uncle

500 Bourbon St., location of 500 Club

one of several clubs owned by Carlos Marcello in 1963 when

LHO took JVB there with Anna and David Lewis to meet Carlos Marcello

Royal Orleans Hotel, 500 block of Royal, enter on St. Louis

where David Ferrie stayed when he first moved to N.O.

rendezvous spot for LHO and JVB

Canal Street - walking tour

2 Canal Street, World Trade Center, formerly International Trade Mart, which was located in CBD nearer to Lafayette Square in 1963

400 block of Canal, Customs House, note importance of trade to New Orleans

500 block of Canal, catch Magazine Street bus

600 block of Canal, 126 Exchange Place, where LHO lived as a teen in 1955

921 Canal, Audubon Building, location of INCA on top floor in rear

INCA was Dr. Ochsner's anti-Communist crusade run by Ed Butler

where Ed Butler worked when he debated LHO in 1963

where Ed Butler showed ETH Guy Banister's files in 1982

900 block Canal, see 123 Baronne, Roosevelt Hotel in 1963

original site of what is now Tulane Medical School in 1834

HQ of Huey Long in 1930s

Last rendezvous spot of LHO and JVB

Next: catch Saint Charles Street Car in 700 block of Canal

St. Charles Ave. - Street Car

catch Saint Charles Street Car in 700 block of Canal or walk five blocks to 500 block
500 block of Saint Charles - get off street car and walk around

Lafayette Square and surrounding buildings

corner of Camp and Lafayette is formerly site of Newman Building
544 Camp St., Guy Banister's office where David Ferrie,
Anna and David Lewis, Jack Martin and LHO frequented

currently site of Hale Boggs Federal Office Building

named for Congressman Boggs who is Cookie Roberts' father
Boggs was a member of LBJ's "Warren Commission"

Boggs died in a unexplained plane crash in 1972

near International House where Dr. Ochsner was President

near old International Trade Mart which Clay Shaw directed

Reily Coffee Company, where LHO and JVB worked in 1963

both hired by Bill Monaghan, a former FBI agent

Federal Buildings, FBI, CIA, Congressional Field Offices

Congressional offices of Willis, Hebert, and Boggs in 1963

>>> get back on street car and continue uptown to University section

1000 Saint Charles, Lee Circle, where ETH worked

3101 Saint Charles Ave., Mary Sherman's apartment building, corner of Harmony St.

3811 Saint Charles Ave, Column's Hotel, near Touro Clinic and original Ochsner Clinic

5120 Saint St. Charles Ave., Latter Library,

near House Party where ETH met Judyth Vary Baker impersonator

6400 Saint Charles Ave.

Exposition Blvd., where Dr. Ochsner, Sr. home overlooked Audubon Park

Loyola University, where Col. Jose Rivera, MD, PhD, taught intro biology

Tulane University - where ETH and Barbara went to school in 1972

6900 Saint Charles Ave., Tulane President's , built by United Fruit Co.'s, Sam Zemurray

Next: street car turns around at the end of the track and goes back to 800 Canal

(aka Bourbon Street in French Quarter)

Tip: Walk through Audubon Park and catch the Magazine Street bus back, ¾ mile walk.

Magazine Street - Bus Trip

catch Magazine St. bus in 500 block of Canal Street, or in Audubon Park
640 Magazine Street, Reily Coffee Company,
where LHO and JVB worked in 1963
4000 block of Magazine where JVB would board Magazine Street Bus
that LHO was riding in the mornings
1 and ½ blocks from 1032 Marengo St. where Judyth Vary Baker's lived in 1963
4905 Magazine St., LHO and Marina Oswald lived in 1963
where LHO would board Magazine Street bus to work in the mornings
6400 Magazine St., Audubon Park,
where LHO and JVB would go after work for private time
once they even rolled down Monkey Hill, a favorite of children in New Orleans
when they rode back, LHO would get off at 4900 and JVB would get off at 4000.
Next: bus will return to Canal Street or walk through Audubon Park and catch street car.

Downtown, City Hall Plaza, walk to corner of Tulane Ave. and Loyola Ave., near CBD

New Orleans Public Library, where Mary Sherman's police and autopsy reports were found
walk one block down Loyola to Gravier St. to corner of Gravier and Loyola
location of Howard Johnson Motel, scene of Ho-Jo Massacre, Jan 1973
one block east is the Rault Center, 1111 Gravier St., scene of hi-rise fire, Dec. 1972

Tulane Ave. - by car

1430 Tulane Ave, Tulane Medical School,
where Mary Sherman and Dr. Haslam taught in 1950s and 1960s
1500 Charity Hospital, where LHO and Judyth met with Ochsner in 1963
1600 LSU Medical School, where Adele Edisen worked and met Dr. Rivera in 1963
2752 Tulane Ave. (at Broad), District Attorney Office, Jim Garrison in 1960s
2752 Tulane Ave. Coroner's Office, site of Mary Sherman's autopsy in 1964
Next: take Broad south to Louisiana Ave. Parkway, one block past Toledano

Louisiana Ave. Parkway - by car

3330 La. Ave. Pkwy, David Ferrie's apartment in 1963

3225 La. Ave. Pkwy, "mouse house" in 1963

3225 La. Ave. Pkwy, Barbara's apartment in 1972

Note: The Katrina flood killed the oak trees, hence the lack of foliage.

Next: Take Claiborne Ave. west to Jefferson Hwy to main Ochsner Clinic

Ochsner Clinic - by car

1516 Jefferson Hwy, main Ochsner Clinic and Hospital

where Mary Sherman and Dr. Ochsner worked in 1964

see statue of Dr. Alton Ochsner, Sr. in front

try to find brick remembering Mary Sherman on the ground

current site of Mary Sherman Bone Pathology Laboratory

4 blocks west is the site of The Beverly nightclub, once

managed by Carlos Marcello, and now an Ochsner parking lot, on LaBarre Rd.

Next: go behind clinic and take River Road to Uptown Riverfront

Uptown Riverfront - by car

River Road leads to Leak Ave. which leads to Magazine St.,

then turn right on River Drive.(see map) go past Zoo,

Audubon Park

Riverfront Park, a spectacular view of the Mississippi River

Zoo, a great zoo by any measure

700 Exposition Blvd., stop to enjoy Cathedral Oak

one of the oldest oak trees in the world

Turn right on Tchoupitoulas Street, for US Public Health Service Hospital

6300 Tchoupitoulas Street, at Calhoun St., former Children's Hospital

6200 Tchoupitoulas Street, at Henry Clay, former USPHS Hospital

both facilities are now called The Regional Medical Center for Children

Lake Pontchartrain - by car

West End Park, harbor where Dr. Haslam kept his sailboat, scene of Pirate incident
painting of Interlude was done from photo taken on Breakwater Point

go east on Lakeshore Drive to Lakefront Airport

where LHO was cadet in David Ferrie's Civil Air Patrol unit in 1950s

will pass Lake Vista, where Dr. Haslam's family lived and where ETH grew up

see map for Lakefront Airport, return by Leon C. Simon to Robert E. Lee.

turn on Wisner Blvd to go along City Park

stop at New Orleans Museum of Art in City Park,

where ETH met Alvin Alcorn

Return Choice: return to French Quarter via Esplanade or go see Jesuit High School

Esplanade route

Beautiful old street that runs to the Mississippi River

Old New Orleans Mint in 400 block at River end

Charming residential end of the French Quarter, walk to Jackson Square

Clay Shaw lived in 1300 block of Royal in 1963

Jesuit High School

Wisner turns to Carrolton, where you will pass Jesuit High School, 4501 S. Carrolton,

where ETH went to high school 1965-69, see The Classroom chapter

you could also see Jesuit on your way out to the lake
